Air Access

The **Ballina Byron Gateway Airport** (BBGA) offers direct services between Sydney, Melbourne and Newcastle with Jetstar, Virgin, REX and Fly Pelican providing up to 58 flights per week. Please refer to Appendix A for an example of a typical week's flight schedule.

The BBGA is a 15 minute drive from the proposed conference venue.

BBGA also offer the option to charter private aircraft into our port, as the aerodrome can operate the lighting system around the clock. For private charter the services of aircraft marshalling, ground handing, refuelling, etc. is available upon request shall you wish to charter aircraft from any other destinations.

The **Gold Coast Airport** at Coolangatta, is located a 55 minute drive from the Lennox Head Cultural and Community Centre. The airport provides direct flights to 11 Australian destinations including: Canberra, Sydney, Melbourne, Newcastle, Adelaide, Caims, Launceston, Perth, Hobart, Townsville and Rockhampton. These flights are serviced by Jetstar, Virgin, Tiger Air, Qantas and Jet Go. International destinations with direct flights from the Gold Coast Airport include Japan, Singapore, Malaysia, New Zealand, Fiji and Hong Kong.

The Pacific Highway upgrade project has now been completed to the north of the shire, making the journey from Ballina to Brisbane a two hour drive. The Pacific Highway in both the north and southbound directions is only a nine minute drive from the proposed conference venue at Lennox Head.



the venue and meeting space

Convene in the heart of Lennox Head

Location

The Lennox Head Cultural and Community Centre is conveniently located in the Lennox Head village centre, on the corner of Park Lane and Mackney Lane. The centre is home to the Park Lane Theatre and has five meeting spaces, a dedicated stage and is walking distance to accommodation, cafes and dining establishments, a shopping precinct, bus stops, beaches, a fresh water lake, headlands and recreation footpaths and cycleways.

The conference venue also provides walking access to Lake Ainsworth, Seven Mile Beach, and the National Surf Reserve at Pat Morton Lookout. All which can provide case study content for the conference program.

The Ballina town centre is a short 15 minute drive from Lennox Head. Refer to Appendix B for a map of the local region.

Venue

Park Lane Theatre within the Lennox Head Cultural and Community Centre can be used for the plenary sessions with it's dedicated stage and tiered seating option. The room has a capacity of 800 pax. Breakout sessions can be hosted in the spaces referred to as Meeting Rooms, Activity Room, Children's Area and CWA Hall. There is also an outdoor courtyard for meal breaks and enjoying the fresh air. The foyer space can be used for delegate registration.

May and June 2020 have full availability as at 9 August 2019 except for the dates of Friday 8 and Saturday 9 May 2020. The total cost of the venue hire is \$3675 for 2.5 full days of conferencing and bump in and bump out either side of start and finish. Please note Council are yet to waive this fee. Please address a letter to Ballina Shire Council if you wish to seek a fee waiver for venue hire.

Audio Visual Technical Support

AV technical support can be provided by James Palmer. James is a skilled audio engineer with years of experience working free lance for the Lennox Head Cultural and Community Centre. James's fees are from \$40 per hour. A quote has been prepared based on bump in, conferencing, awards ceremony and bump out. Please refer to Appendix C for further information.


Delegate Information Packs


